The main CHALLENGE for university students and researchers

SOLUTION to these problems: TESTÉALO

A cooperative initiative that allows students, researchers, and recent graduates to validate their business ideas in real market conditions, supported by the Union of Working Associated Cooperatives in the Region of Murcia UCOMUR in collaboration with the University of Murcia (UMU) and the Polytechnic University of Cartagena (UPCT).

Actions complemented by UE and Regional Programs supporting the SE entrepreneurship ecosystem.

Objectives and Target



- 1) Identify innovative and creative business ideas.
- 2) Provide training and mentoring to transform them into real business projects.

Target group: UMU and UPCT students, staff, and graduates (up to 5 years).
